COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MINUTES - 8 MAY 2002

MINUTE NO. 630/02 COMMITTEE DECISION

That the findings of the Halls Position Paper be endorsed, namely:

- a. That the ownership and management of community halls remain with Council unless specific viable local alternatives emerge.
- b. That where local alternatives are considered they should be reported on a case by case basis.
- c. That Council focuses on upgrading building maintenance on its halls with particular reference to improving, toilets, kitchens, storage areas and disabled facilities.
- d. That operational management continues to be refined with an emphasis on increasing usage and improving booking systems.
- e. That no further 'conventionally' designed halls be constructed. In future, consideration should be given to multi-purpose facilities.
