

## Beaches and Walkways

Manukau has over 300 kilometres of coastline of which over 100 kilometres is either esplanade reserve or functions as esplanade reserve (legal road). In addition there are 30 kilometres of esplanade along major watercourses in the city.

Esplanade reserves protect conservation values and provide public access to the sea, rivers and lakes.

The Howick-Pakuranga-Clevedon coastline offers a variety of beautiful beaches for safe swimming and water sports, including Bucklands Beach, Cockle Bay, Eastern Beach, Half Moon Bay, Maraetai Beach, the Pohutukawa Coast, and Orere Point.

On the western shores of the City visit the Puhinui Stream, Kiwi Esplanade or Weymouth Beach.

There are also a number of esplanade walkways currently in place and a number yet to be developed. Current walkways include the Cascades Walkway, Pakuranga Rotary Walkway, Wattle Downs Walkway, Weymouth Walkway, Kiwi Esplanade Walkway, Otara Creek Walkway and the Awaroa Walkway (low tide access only).
