Kawakawa Bay Coast Road Reserve - on foreshore next to jetty (All tide)

Maraetai Park - from helipad to water edge

Omana Esplanade, Maraetai - off Omana Esplanade, near main gateway

Sunkist Bay Reserve, Beachlands

- far end of reserve by seawall
- below wooden jetty

Cockle Bay Reserve

Howick Beach

- opposite Howick Sea Rescue
- first boat ramp on access way
- opposite Kiosk

### Pakuranga

Ara Tai Esplanade Reserve, Half Moon Bay (All tide)

Bucklands Beach

- dingy ramp north of main boat ramp
- main boat ramp
- Grangers Point

Eastern Beach, Tiraumea Drive Reserve

### Mangere

Mangere Bridge - end of Coronation Road near old harbour bridge (All tide)

Kiwi Esplanade

- in front of Manukau Boat Club
- in front of Manukau Yacht Club by playgrounds

### Manurewa

Greers Road Foreshore

Hazards Road Foreshore

Keith Park, Weymouth

- ramp from rowing club to water edge
- from sea scouts hall to water
