

Information sheet for on-licence (for conveyance)



Section 9, Sale of Liquor Act 1989

To: Auckland Franklin Manukau North Shore Papakura Rodney Waitakere

You are about to apply for an *On-licence*, that is, you wish to sell alcohol to people for the consumption of liquor ON the conveyance ONLY.

To complete this application you will need to answer **all** the questions that follow and supply **all** the documents required.

Once you have all the necessary documents and completed the application form, make an appointment with the local District Licensing Agency and come in with the following:

Tick box

- The prescribed fee of **\$793.24** (includes GST at 15%). The fee is not refundable.
- Three copies of the completed application plus the original plus all documentation.
- Safe Ship Management Certificate (ship, ferry or hovercraft) or a current certificate of airworthiness (if an aircraft).
- A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation (if in company name).
- A copy of the floor plans of the conveyance.
- On the plans, highlight the areas that are Restricted or Supervised and the Principal entrance.
- A copy of the menu.
- A copy of your host responsibility policy.
- Photo of the conveyance.
- A letter of Authorisation for the consultant, if you use a liquor licensing consultant.

When you have the required documentation, you can lodge your application.

Then you can place the public notices.

The Sale of Liquor Act states:

(1) Section 9(4): (Form 1) Within 20 working days after filing the application, the applicant shall give public notice of the application in the prescribed form.

(2) Section 9(5): (Form 1A) Within 10 working days after filing the application, the applicant must ensure that notice of the application in the prescribed form is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which the application relates.

Note: Failure to supply all the required documents may result in your application being returned.

2. For the matters that are to accompany this application, see regulation 5(3) of the Sale of Liquor Act 1990.
3. Within 20 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Agency, the applicant must give public notice of the application in form 1. The notice must be published twice in a newspaper or newspapers circulating in the district and nominated by the Secretary of the District Licensing Agency, with not less than 5 days and not more than 10 days between the 2 dates of publication.
4. Within 10 working days after filing this application with the District Licensing Agency, the applicant must ensure that notice of the application in form 1A is attached in a conspicuous place on or adjacent to the site to which the application relates (unless the Secretary of the District Licensing Agency agrees that it is impracticable or unreasonable to do so).
